


List of Security-sensitive Biological Agents Variation No 1 of 2009

I, NICOLA ROXON, Minister for Health and Ageing, under paragraph 32(1)(a) of the *National Health Security Act 2007*, vary the List of Security-sensitive Biological Agents made on 10 November 2008 by including the following biological agents that I consider to be of security concern to Australia.

Tier 2 Agents
<i>African swine fever virus</i>
<i>Capripoxvirus</i> (<i>Sheep pox virus</i> and <i>Goat pox virus</i>)
<i>Classical swine fever virus</i>
<i>Clostridium botulinum</i> (Botulism; toxin-producing strains)
<i>Francisella tularensis</i> (Tularaemia)
<i>Lumpy skin disease virus</i>
<i>Peste-des-petits-ruminants virus</i>
<i>Salmonella</i> Typhi (Typhoid)
<i>Vibrio cholerae</i> (Cholera) (serotypes O1 and O139 only)
<i>Yellow fever virus</i> (non-vaccine strains)

This variation will commence on 31 January 2010.
